You've probably heard all kinds of numbers flying around about a new Vikings stadium and multi-purpose facility in Arden Hills. Here are the real numbers. We think they add up to **Let's Go!**

\$407,000,000 The Vikings contribution.
Third largest in NFL history.

30 Years. Length of the new Vikings lease.

65,000 Seats. Expandable to
72,000 for Super Bowl.

1 Roof. (Preferably retractable)

21,000 Parking spaces. (Tailgating returns!)

7,500 Construction jobs.

13,000 Total jobs supported by construction.

3,400 Full and part-time jobs
once stadium opens.

\$300,000,000 Approximate wages paid
during 3-year building period.

\$21,000,000 Direct taxes paid annually
by the Vikings and visiting NFL teams.

\$200,000,000 Estimated economic
impact of one Super Bowl at the new stadium.

90 Percent of annual operating expenses
to be paid by Vikings.

100 Percent of the stadium owned
by the public.

300 Days the people's stadium will be
available for non-Vikings events.

0 Dollars used from Minnesota's
General Fund.

stadiums since 1992.

32 Vikings' ranking (last) in NFL stadium
revenues and game day experience.

2,500,000 Minnesotans following the Vikes
every Sunday.

And the bottom line at this point:

34 Number of votes needed in the
Minnesota Senate.

68 Number of votes needed in the
Minnesota House.
