

Tailgating Terms & Conditions

- The Vikings have instituted a pre-paid parking permit program for as many fans as possible. This pre-paid parking policy is necessary due to the limited volume of spaces available.
- All vehicles parking on the Vikings lots will require a parking permit or prepaid ticket. Any additional spaces (if available) that were sold in addition to vehicle spaces must also have a ticket.
- The parking lots will open for tailgating as follows: 12pm games - lots open at 6am; 3pm games - lots open at 8am.
- Larger vehicles requiring additional spaces will be directed into designated areas by Parking and Traffic Staff on the Purple Tailgate 3. Each fan will be required to pay for each space or partial space used by their vehicle, set-up, or accessories. This is in order to be fair and accommodate as many fans as possible, and to keep the prices as low as possible.
- Parking for guests with disabilities is available in Purple Tailgate 1. These spaces are in addition to the existing spaces on the Disabled lot located at 6th St. and Park Avenue. A state-issued accessible parking plate or placard must be displayed on any vehicle parking in these spaces. Ticket holders with ADA plates or placards must also possess a pre-paid parking permit for the appropriate game to park in these lots.
- To ensure safety and efficient travel throughout the Vikings lots, Parking and Security staff will direct traffic inside the lots and may request where you park your vehicle. This is done in order to make efficient use of all spaces inside the lots. Please follow the directions of the Parking and Security Staff. Any fan refusing to do as requested, may face revocation of parking privileges.
- Circulation between parking lots is not possible due to fan safety concerns and municipal laws. Vehicles will be directed to the appropriate parking lots with available parking spaces based on your parking permit designation.
- Illegal parking on area roadways, medians, grass malls, alleys, and vehicle breakdown lanes is prohibited. Violators will be ticketed by local police and/or towed at owner's expense.
- **Wood burning fires are strongly prohibited** on the Vikings tailgating parking lots due to Minneapolis City Ordinances. Violators are subject to fine, ejection from the lot, and revocation of their tailgating passes for the remainder of the season with no refund.
- **Litter dumping or charcoal dumping** on the parking lot grounds **is not permitted**. Violators are subject to fine, ejection from the lot, and revocation of their tailgating passes with no refund.
- **Public urination is illegal and not permitted** on parking lot grounds. Violators are subject to fine, ejection from the lot, and revocation of their tailgating passes with no refund.
- **Amplified sound from vehicles is not permitted**. Violators are subject to fine, ejection from the lot, and revocation of their tailgating passes with no refund.
- **Solicitation is not permitted**. The sales of merchandise, including but not limited to jerseys, beads, hats, shirts, is **NOT PERMITTED**. Violators are subject to fine, ejection from the lot, and revocation of their tailgating passes with no refund.
- All RV/Busses/Oversize Vehicles must park in Purple Tailgate 3. RVs will be required to pay for a minimum of **three** parking spaces. This is why RV season passes are offered apart from regular season passes for Purple Tailgate 3. In the event that less than three

- season passes are presented for an RV upon entry, additional spaces must be purchased for the posted rates in order to be allowed entry to the lot. In the event of a dispute over the size of a vehicle, parking staff will determine what constitutes an oversize vehicle and may direct vehicles to Purple Tailgate 3 if deemed appropriate or necessary.
- All spaces occupied by vehicle and its occupants must be paid for - strictly enforced by parking and security staff.

General Information

- Tailgating has become a ritual at the Dome and is permitted provided guests tailgate in the same space occupied by their vehicle, and or limited to spaces they have purchased permits for. Please be courteous to your fellow fans -- open parking spaces can not be used for tailgating unless paid for.
- Ticket Holders may not reserve adjacent parking spaces for others. In order to use all spaces in the parking lots, parking and security staff will direct cars where to park as they arrive when needed.
- Tailgating is not permitted in the drive lanes, or other non-designated areas.
- Grills are permitted for tailgating enjoyment, provided guests do so only in the same space occupied by their vehicle. However, their use near buildings or in areas where guests or property may be damaged is strictly prohibited.
- Please do not discard hot coals near vehicles or in plastic waste receptacles: For your safety and convenience, hot coal bins have been provided for the disposal of charcoal. These large "hot charcoal" bins are located on the islands/plazas between the parking lots. PLEASE DO NOT DISCARD TRASH IN THE HOT COAL BINS OR HOT COAL ASHES IN THE TRASH CONTAINERS.
- Trash receptacles are located throughout the parking lots and near the Stadium entrances. Please bag and dispose of your trash to make it safer for vehicles exiting the lots after the game.
- Outside catering companies are not permitted on the Vikings lots.
