VIKINGS, U.S. MARINES AND NATIONAL GUARD TEAM UP TO COLLECT TOYS PRIOR TO SUNDAY'S VIKINGS- BENGALS GAME

MINNEAPOLIS – The Minnesota Vikings are encouraging fans to bring new, unwrapped gifts to the December 13 game against the Cincinnati Bengals at Mall of America Field to help brighten the holiday season for local youngsters.

The Vikings are teaming up with the U.S. Marines and National Guard for the game to support their youth-oriented holiday programs. Marines will be collecting “Toys for Tots” and cash donations from fans for the annual Minnesota Vikings Toy Drive at the gates. For fans not able to bring an unwrapped toy, members of the National Guard will also be collecting cash at each gate for its “Defending the Line” program, which provides athletic equipment for local children of deployed soldiers unable to buy equipment.

The collection begins at 10 a.m. and lasts through kickoff at noon.
